1. Call meeting to order

**Northwestern Street Flooding-** Jeff spoke with Tom Janke regarding the water, it looks like there is work being done by the county, so this issue should be resolved.

**Tom Thielman-** Spoke to the board about the water issue on his property located at W6626 Subway Road. The board a retention pond may be in his best interest.

**Variance Meeting-** The variance meeting which was to be held on 5-29-2017 was changed to 5-31-17 by the appeals board chairman without proper notice. The board contacted the attorney as to whether the appeals for Sonnenfeld's and Flood Mobile Homes would need to be reheard. It was left to the board to decide. Motion O'Brien, second by Meisenburg to approve the change in date without proper notice. All in favor, motion carried.
