## *Town Board Meetings:*

Board meetings are held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of the month at 7:30pm at the Friendship Town Hall. Agendas are posted on the web page and at Hounsell's, the Town Hall and Post Office. If you have something you would like to have addressed at a regularly scheduled board meeting, please contact the clerk or chairman no later than the Saturday prior to the meeting.

## **ATV/UTV Ordinance**

The Town of Friendship recently passed an ATV/UTV Ordinance, golf carts, however, are not allowed. All roads traveled must be posted with our ATV Route signs. All state laws do apply and you cannot drive on State Highways or County Roads. This includes Highway 45, County Road RP, and County Road N. You will be allowed to travel across these roads but not down

these roads. Roads will be posted with a speed limit. All ATV/UTVs must yield for traffic and also must stay on the road way while operating on Town Roads. You will not be allowed to travel in the ditch. If you have any questions please check out our Ordinance on our website in the Ordinance section and also on the DNR webpage for complete rules and regulations.

## **Snow Removal**

The Town of Friendship has an ordinance, 6-4-3, regarding the removal of snow and ice from sidewalks; this also includes the area over a driveway and the handicap ramp areas. Snow must be removed within 24 hours after it stops. Failure to comply

will result in a fine. It is also against the law to plow, blow or shovel snow into or across a road.

Garbage pickup for the entire Town of Friendship is every Thursday. Please have your containers out to the street by 6:00am on Thursday morning and remove your containers from the street by 8:00pm Thursday evening. Removing bins from the road promptly in the winter will also insure they will not be damaged by the snow plow.

Waste Management may refuse to pick up any containers that are overflowing and covers not closed. Recycling is picked up every other Thursday with same rules applying.
